


The Game - Das Spiel


With the referee Fedayi San we experience the highs and lows of a football game, what it means to earn respect on the field and direct the energy of an entire stadium.

Directors statement

The referee has the power to decide over yellow or red card, penalty or no penalty. His judgement can make the difference between victory and defeat. Within a heartbeat he can turn into a tragic figure forced to withhold the rage of an entire stadium. It was my intention to show the person who takes those decisions. Therefore I took a glimpse behind the curtains of a soccer game in an informative but endearing way. By closing in on family relationships and on player-referee interactions, the film allows the audience to experience the sheer unbearable pressure of a referee while getting to know the person under the referee jersey: Fedayi San – a human being with fears and doubts.


Fedayi San - Protagonist

Fedayi San was born and grew up near Zurich, Switzerland as the youngest son of Turkish immigrants. As a child he played football ambitiously and started refereeing on the side at the age of 17. Quite unexpectedly, this led to a steep career as a football official. "Back then I earned more as a referee than I did with my day job".

When, aged 28, he received an offer from the Challenge League (the second division). Fedayi was picked to replace a sick colleague in the top division of Swiss football, the Super League. He fulfilled the assignment with flying colours. "In the end I had to send off the goalie," says Fedayi grinning.

16 years after his first assignment as an official, he got chosen as one of the seven Swiss FIFA officials.

Fedayi carries big hopes on his shoulders: at long last, a Swiss official is supposed to referee one of the really big tournaments once again. His wish: "To hear the Champions League anthem first hand."
